Cinema Trips: Reception and KS1 (Monday 18th December) KS2 (Friday 15th December)

We are really excited to be heading back to the cinema this year, for our traditional Christmas visit. Reception, KS1 and KS2 will be watching Arthur Christmas (Certificate U). Please make a payment of £3.20 via ParentPay and complete the permission slip below in order for your child to attend. This includes a small packet of Haribo.

Christmas Cards: Handed in between 11th and 15th December.

We absolutely love that pupils enjoy writing for a purpose, which means that this year, pupils are able to write Christmas Cards for their friends and teachers. Pupils can drop their Christmas cards off at the school post box (located by the office) between the 11th and 15th of December. Our Pupil Leadership Team will then organise the cards ready to be handed out. Christmas cards must include a first name, surnames (if you know them) and class name, as this will really help Santa's helpers!

Christmas Lunch (Reception- Y6) and Christmas Jumpers: Wednesday 6th December

We can't have Christmas without a Christmas Lunch, whilst wearing a Christmas Jumper!

The Christmas Lunch will consist of the usual Christmas Turkey/Quorn Fillet option, with roast potatoes, a chipolata sausage, stuffing, vegetables and gravy. For dessert children will be able to choose from a Christmas Yule Log or a Christmas Shortbread biscuit.

There will be no cost for Christmas Lunch if your child is in Reception, Y1 and Y2, due to the universal free school meal scheme: however, please still book this via ParentPay by Friday 24th November as we need to know the numbers. KS2 pupils should also book and make the usual payment via Parent Pay by Friday 24th November if they would like a Christmas Lunch. For children who are eligible for Free School Meals, no payment is needed but you **must** still make a booking.

Thank you for taking the time to read our plans for Christmas this year. **Please ensure that the slip below is returned by Friday 1st December.** If you have any questions at all, please do not hesitate to ask.

Our last day of term is Tuesday 19th December. If your child is in Nursery, Reception, Year One and Year Two, the finish time is 1pm. For pupils in Years Three, Four, Five and Six, the finish time is 1:15. Here's to a great month of fun and learning in school!
