What we've been learning recently

English – We have started writing about Paddington! We have been using adjectives and emotions to write captions to describe how Paddington might have felt as he arrived in London. Then we looked at the features of a postcard. We then wrote a postcard to Aunt Lucy to tell her all about Paddington's adventures.

Maths – We have been continuing with our addition and subtraction learning journey. Using our knowledge of number bonds to 10 we have been working out addition fact families. This then led onto using a part whole model to work out a part to fill in the missing number from a number sentence.

Wider Curriculum – In Science, we have been exploring the question 'What is seasonal change?'. We have looked at the 4 seasons thinking about the typical weather each season would have as well as what clothing would be appropriate to wear. We also thought about the changes in nature and wildlife such as how trees change over the seasons.
