English – This week in English we have been writing our own set of instructions on 'How to Wash a Woolly Mammoth'. The children have been using their newly taught skills on the features of instructional writing such as chronology and imperative verbs. These instructions will feature in their Star Writer Books which highlight their best pieces of writing across the year.

Maths – In the last fortnight, children have been learning about length and perimeter and how to calculate the perimeter. We have measured in mm, cm and m and converted between units.
