What we've been learning recently

English – Over the last two weeks, Year 4 have been using the exciting picture story "Leon and the Place Between" as a stimulus for writing about their own imaginary worlds. They have created a story map to plan out their ideas and generate lots of ambitious vocabulary. They are now writing up their stories using their best handwriting.

Maths – Multiplication and division has been the focus in Maths this half term. The children have investigated and made links between the 3, 6 and 9 times table and are becoming more confident with their recall of the 7, 11 and 12 times tables.

Wider Curriculum – The focus question for Geography this term is "Do rainforests need our help?". The children have learnt where in the world rainforests can be found and can now describe the diverse layers of the rainforest. In D&T, the children have been excellent "Keep Going Koala's" and persevered with their sewing skills to create a book cover. Well done Year 4!
