What we've been learning recently

English – This week, Year 4 have been looking at how to write a persuasive letter. We learnt how to plan an argument using emotive language, rhetorical questions and quotes from experts to back up our own opinions. We are beginning to write letters to persuade loggers not to chop down the rainforest and to save the precious animals and plants within it.

Maths – Last week, we learnt how to work out the area of a 2-D shape. This week, we have explored perimeter using mm, cm and m to solve word problems involving both area and perimeter.

Wider Curriculum – The focus question for Geography this term is “Do Rainforests need our help?”. This week, we have learnt about the people who live in the rainforest and discovered that there are some large cities within the rainforest itself. We learn how the indigenous people live and find food in this beautiful but difficult environment.
