## What we've been learning recently

English – Over the past two weeks, we've been working on persuasive writing. The students have written a letter to the King, arguing why mathematician and scientist Katherine Johnson should be added to the honours list. This task helps develop both their writing and critical thinking skills, while also encouraging them to think about social justice and recognising unsung heroes.

Maths – We've been learning how to multiply fractions with whole numbers and simplify fractions. The students have been practising these skills in fun, real-life scenarios. Encouraging them to practise at home will boost their confidence and help them tackle more challenging problems.

Wider curriculum – In science, we've been exploring the solar system, Earth's rotation and orbit, and how day and night happen. We'll also discuss how the Earth's position affects the seasons. This topic has sparked curiosity about space and the world around us.

- We will continue to learn and deepen our knowledge of fractions.
- We are wrapping up our Science learning about Earth and Space.
