


Year 6 News 6th December 2024









What we've been learning recently

English – Over the past two weeks, the children have delved deeper into *Darwin's Dragons*. They have honed various grammatical skills, including the use of parenthesis and techniques from DADWAVERS. Building on their understanding of the text, the children planned alternative endings for the narrative, using their own predictions and inferences to guide their ideas.

Maths – In Maths, the children have been developing their understanding of multiplying and dividing fractions. They practiced multiplying and dividing fractions by integers and other fractions and solving mixed-fraction problems. They also explored finding fractions of an amount and determining the whole from a fraction.

Wider Curriculum – In our wider curriculum, we wrapped up our science journey by constructing circuits, designing traffic light systems, and applying our understanding of conductors and insulators. We then transitioned into Geography, diving into the fascinating theme of Population.

Over the next fortnight we will be...

- In English, we will be starting our new Christmas learning journey, writing formally in the style of Buddy the Elf!
- In Maths, we'll be moving on to measurements, converting units.
- Ending our Wider Curriculum unit on Geography and completing our end of unit assessments.
