


Year 6 News 31st January 2025









What we've been learning recently

English – Over the past two weeks, the children have been hard at work crafting their non-chronological reports inspired by the text *Holes*. They have meticulously edited, refined, and redrafted their writing before presenting their final pieces in their Star Writer books. Following this, we embarked on an exciting new journey into biographies, exploring the remarkable work of Charles Darwin.

Maths – In Maths, the children have now completed their learning journey through algebra. With plenty of practice during our morning work, they successfully combined White Rose steps to deepen their understanding. They have explored expressions, inputs and outputs, problem-solving, and identifying mathematical pathways. Next, we move on to decimals!
