### What we've been learning recently

Literacy – Last week, our focus text was The Little Red Hen. The children enjoyed learning the story using actions so they could retell it orally. To immerse them in the story, the children got to bake and eat bread rolls. Many of them commented that it was the best snack time ever! In Phonics, we have focused on our letter formation, segmenting, blending and reading captions including tricky words.

Maths – Last week, we were finding 1 more and 1 less. We also continued to develop our ability to subitize numbers 1-5. This week, we have been learning to recognise 4 sided shapes. The children noticed that there are lots of 4 sided shapes in our learning environment.

Wider Curriculum – It's been very busy in Reception over the past two weeks. Some highlights include taking part in the Santa Fun Run, eating Christmas Lunch, watching the KS1 Nativity and performing in the Reception and Nursery Christmas Singalong. The children have also made Christmas calendars, cards and decorations.

#### Next term we will be...

- Starting our new Winter Topic which includes learning about animals and their habitats.
- Beginning to learn Level 3 sounds and tricky words in Phonics.
- Starting a unit of gymnastics lessons in PE.
