What we've been learning recently

Literacy – Last week, we based our learning around the animated story: The Girl Who Went to the Arctic. The children learned how to write a list and wrote down 5 items they would take with them on an adventure to the Arctic. This week, we learned the story of Chinese New Year and found out how the animals of the Chinese Zodiac decided who would have which year named after them.

Maths – Last week, the children were exploring mass and capacity. They enjoyed using balancing scales and exploring capacity in the water trays. This week, they explored the number 6 and its composition.

Wider Curriculum – In week 3, we learned about the indigenous people who live in the Arctic. The children learned about what these people eat, the clothes they wear, their modes of transport and the houses they live in. We compared living in Wadebridge to living in the Arctic and the children were able to talk about similarities and differences. This week, we have been celebrating Chinese New Year and learning about different customs and traditions.

Over the next fortnight we will be...

- Basing our learning around a new text: The Polar Bear and the Snow Cloud.
- Learning more about the animals that inhabit the polar regions.
- Continuing to take part in cookery lessons on Wednesdays.
- Going on a trip to The Eden Project for a workshop on the ice!
